This is a painted stone house with a hipped corrugated iron roof with a separate verandah roof to the front (east) which is supported on metal posts with a metal frieze and brackets. The openings to the front of the building are enhanced by rendered quoining, the doorway being further emphasised by contrasting paint colours to its quoining. Windows are timber framed and double hung and there are two rendered masonry chimneys which punctuate the roof-scape. The property is bounded to the street by a scalloped metal fence.
