This is a timber framed and weatherboard clad house with an aluminium tiled gambrel roof with a separate gable roof to the front elevation. The main roof extends to cover the verandahs to the north and north east. The verandah is supported on turned timber verandah posts with a decorative timber frieze. There is a lean to roof to the rear and awnings to windows. A corbelled brick chimney punctuates the roof to the south.
