This building has three distinct sections with a complex roof structure. The front section (the theatre foyer) is constructed of light coloured brick and has twin tiled skillion roofs with a verandah supported on brick columns to the north and west sides. Behind the front brick section there are two steel framed sections clad with fibro. A gable asbestos roof covers the main theatre, beyond this a skillion roof sloping to the rear covers the stage area which is accessed by a large sliding door set above a delivery ramp with timber steps.

The Geraldton Repertory Club began in 1932, and the Geraldton Concert Artists formed in 1961. "Theatre 8" was formed in 1974 with the amalgamation of the Geraldton Repertory Club and the Geraldton Concert Artists. The present stage area was the original hall for the Repertory Club and additions to accommodate a workshop, wardrobe room, green room and kitchen to cater for 100 patrons has since been added. The theatre auditorium is named for Jim Wilson, life member and stage manager for many years.
