This simple timber framed house is clad with fibro sheeting. A corrugated iron gambrel roof extends to cover the front verandah which is supported on timber posts. There is a tall corbelled brick chimney to the north east and a lean-to at the rear. The central entry door has timber framed double hung windows symmetrically placed each side. A white picket fence to the front boundary is punctuated by a decorative entry portico which lines up with the front door of the house.
