This brick house has a hipped corrugated iron roof which extends to cover the verandah which is supported on timber posts with a decorative frieze between. To the south a separate gable roof covers the main room. The gable end is enclosed with fibro and there is an awning to the window below. To the front facade, the face brickwork is tuckpointed and a rendered band runs at verandah frieze height. A brick chimney punctuates the roofscape. A brick wall with brick columns and pickets with a gate forms the street boundary.
