This timber framed weatherboard clad house has a gambrel roof with two separate gable roofs to the east and north. The gable ends are enclosed with lath and timber batten. Between the gables the main roof extends to cover verandahs which are supported on timber posts. The window to the north gable has a corrugated iron awning. Windows are timber framed and double hung. There is a lean-to roof to the rear. A timber picket fence forms the property frontage.
