Situated on a corner lot, this house has a hipped corrugated iron roof, painted green, which extends to cover the front verandah to the north. A gable roof covers the main room to the building's front. The gable end has decorative vertical timber work with braces to the eaves. There is a corrugated iron awning to the window below the gable end. A rendered brick chimney punctuates the western side of the roof. The windows are eight pane casement style. A solar hot water system installed to the front of the roof is an intrusive element.
