This long painted brick building has a hipped corrugated iron roof with a feature gablet to the front (east) elevation. A separate corrugated iron bull nose verandah roof is enhanced by a gable which extends to the east and emphasises the entrance. The verandah is supported on chamfered timber posts with a decorative moulding and struts to the plain verandah frieze. Windows are timber framed and double hung.

This building was used by the Overseas Telecommunications Commission and had large aerials located adjacent, from Francis Street through to Cunningham Street.
