This painted stone house fronts directly on to the street and has an L-shaped gable roof with a lean-to roof to the rear. A separate hipped verandah roof to the front (west) of the building is supported on Tuscan concrete columns set on rendered masonry piers with a rendered masonry balustrade. The stonework is random rubble, windows are timber framed and double hung, one window to the west gable has a corrugated iron awning and there is a rendered brick chimney to the south east.
