This building has undergone substantial additions and alterations over time to facilitate its differing uses from residence to restaurant and office. The original front section of the building fronts onto the footpath on the western side and consists of an aluminium framed window either side of a central door. A recent large addition to the eastern side has almost doubled the size of the building as it presents from Armstrong Street. A separate bullnose verandah runs along the street frontage of the building and appears to be a later modification. The verandah is supported on timber posts with decorative braces and a simple timber balustrade. The building has rendered masonry walls and features a rendered, corbelled chimney to the west of the main roof.

The Russell family from Moonyoonooka lived here at one time. (Source M. Cramer, further details available from Poppy Anderson.) During the 1990s the building accommodated The Alamo Restaurant (Mexican) prior to being refurbished for use as an office. A large addition was subsequently			

being refurbished for use as an office. A large addition was subsequently built to the side of the building to enlarge it considerably. In 2009 the building housed SGIO and Equity Financial Planners.
