This is a small rendered masonry and weatherboard cottage with a hipped roof. A weatherboard clad extension with a gable roof has been added to the north west. A separate bullnosed verandah roof running the length of the front facade is a later modification. There is a rendered masonry corbelled chimney to the north east and a weatherboard enclosed lean-to to the rear. A large garage is located immediately to
