This brick house has a gambrel corrugated iron roof with a slatted gable to the street facade. The roof below the gablet extends to cover the front verandah which is supported on metal posts. The centre of the verandah is enhanced by a gable, the gable end being roughcast. The verandah ends below the roof have lattice infill. The brick walls have been rendered and painted to the side with roughcast stucco finish to the front except below the windows which are painted brick. Windows are small paned casement style. There is a brick chimney to the rear and a garage attached to the east elevation. A fence of brick pier construction with iron infill forms the property boundary.
