This rendered stone house has a hipped aluminium tiled roof and a skillion roof to the rear. The rear skillion extends to cover an extension which is clad with fibro sheeting. A rendered and corbelled chimney is situated to the south east. The main roof extends to form the front verandah roof which is hipped to each end. The verandah is fully enclosed with unsympathetic brick veneer and louvre windows. One window to the west has a corrugated iron awning. There is a low masonry wall to the property frontage.

Although the place has been considerably altered, it still has some aesthetic significance for its simple and still identifiable original form, scale and use of construction materials to the main section of the building. The verandah accretions and unsympathetic roof cladding can be reversed which would considerably enhance the significance of the place.
