This rendered masonry house has a corrugated iron gambrel roof which extends to cover the front verandah. The centre of the verandah is enhanced by a separate gable, the gable end of which has a roughcast and timber finish. The verandah is supported on twin decorated half timber posts mounted on masonry piers with a masonry balustrade between them. The verandah posts have decorative braces to the verandah beam. Windows are timber framed and double hung with six pane above and single pane below. There is a tall rendered masonry chimney to the west. A low corrugated asbestos fence forms the front property boundary.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Much of the original fabric and style of this house remains intact and as such it is a good example of a rendered brick house of its era. Decorative elements to the verandah and gable end combine to give this place streetscape value.

RECOMMENDATION: Property owners should be encouraged to retain and enhance the character houses located in Du Boulay Street which, together with the gardens and row of street trees, present as a special streetscape worthy of preservation.
