This house has a gambrel roof with double gablets to one end, and a dormer window to the front and centre. A separate verandah roof is supported on half twin timber verandah posts supported on masonry piers with a rendered masonry balustrade between them. An arched verandah frieze joins to the verandah posts. The windows are timber framed casement style. The house has been extended to the west in identical style to the original with double french doors to the new section. There is a garage under the main roof to the east.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Although partly hidden by a wall and extended, this house enhances the streetscape of Du Boulay Street given its simple style and decorative elements such as verandah detailing, which have been retained and reproduced to the front facade of the addition.
