This stucco rendered masonry house has a colorbond roof with a complex roof structure. There is a gambrel roof to the west, a hipped roof to the east with a small gable to the south. To the rear (north) there is a gambrel roof with a skillion roof beyond. A separate verandah roof runs along the front facade and it is supported on half timber posts an masonry piers with a rendered masonry balustrade between them. The verandah posts have attached small timber wings which act as braces to the verandah beam. Windows are casement style to the side with double hung windows and french doors to the verandah.
