This is one of two semi detached painted brick houses. Situated on a corner location, this house has an aluminium tiled gambrel roof with a separate verandah roof to the front (east) which is supported on metal posts with a metal balustrade. To the front facade, the painted brick has a rendered masonry band to half window height. Twin windows are set each side of the central doorway. Windows are timber framed and double hung. A brick wall to the south separates the two verandahs. (See also 76 Gregory Street).
