Set close to the street boundary, this painted concrete block house has a corrugated iron gambrel roof. A separate hipped roof covers a verandah to the front and a fibro enclosed area to the south. The front verandah is supported on turned timber posts which have decorative fretwork brackets. The front facade has contrasting paint treatment which highlights the quoining to the doorway and windows which are timber framed and double hung.
