This stone house is set close to the street with the verandah balustrade forming the street boundary. A hipped corrugated iron roof has a steep skillion roof to the rear with a lean-to roof to a fibro clad extension beyond. To the front (east) elevation there is a separate hipped verandah roof supported on half timber posts with a masonry balustrade below. The stone to the house is ashlar rendered. Windows are timber framed double hung 12 pane.
