This timber framed weatherboard clad house has a gambrel corrugated iron roof which extends to cover the verandah to the front (west) elevation. The gable end is enclosed with weatherboard, below is a corrugated iron awning to the window of the main room. The verandah is supported on turned timber posts and has a weatherboard infill to the north end. The windows are timber framed and double hung with french doors to the verandah and stained glass to the main entry door. A metal chimney is sited to the rear of the main roof.
