This brick house has a gambrel roof which extends to cover the surrounding verandahs. The verandahs are supported on timber posts			

with decorative braces to the verandah beam. The walls are stucco rendered to window sill height with face brick below. Windows are small paned timber framed casement style. A tall brick chimney is sited to the rear of the main roof. A car port in sympathetic style has been added to the side and a scalloped Gothic picket fence forms the street boundary.
