This single storey combination painted and rendered brick shop has large aluminium framed windows and a sliding door to the front facade. Above a suspended box awning there is a tall triangular parapet wall with some detailing to lateral pediments.

This shop housed Gilda Studio, a photography shop, from the early 1930s until c1960. Stan Gratte worked there in the late 1940s. (Source: Stan Gratte) According to Shirley Scotter the shop also accommodated Bon Johnson Menswear which was run by the Johnson family for many years.
