This house was demolished in c2000 to accommodate extensions to the Geraldton Fish Markets site. The following description is from the 1997 Municipal Inventory: Situated on a corner location this brick house has a steeply pitched hipped corrugated iron roof which extends to cover verandahs to the front (west) and south which are supported on metal posts. To the rear there is a timber framed fibro clad extension with a lean-to roof. The south verandah is enclosed with brick and aluminium frame windows. Windows to the house are timber framed and double hung with six pane to the top and single pane below. There is a low brick wall to the street boundary.
