This small timber framed cottage has a gable roof with a broken back extension to the rear and front which covers a partially enclosed verandah. The house has been reclad with fibro plank and has aluminium window frames. A flat roofed car port has been added to the side.

It is believed that this house was originally connected with a market gardening operation. The market gardening industry was especially prevalent in Geraldton from the 1930s, in particular tomato growing. The increasing population in Geraldton has seen many of the areas previously used for market gardens, such as Spalding, subdivided for residential purposes.
