This timber framed house has a corrugated iron gambrel roof with a separate gable roof to the front (south), a lean-to roof to the rear and an addition with a gable roof beyond. A separate hipped verandah roof to the front and west sides is supported on timber posts with a timber balustrade to the front. The side verandah is enclosed with fibro to the west facade. The house has weatherboard cladding to the sides and fibro sheeting to the front. There is a corbelled brick chimney to the lean-to roof at the rear and a low rendered masonry wall to the street boundary.
