Inis timber tramed house is clad with painted corrugated iron to the sides with ripple iron to the front main room. The roof is hipped corrugated iron with a separate gable to the front and a skillion roof to the rear with a lean-to roof beyond which covers a weatherboard clad extension. The front verandah has a separate roof which is supported on timber posts with fibro and louvre window infill to the front and side. An awning to the side window is made of corrugated iron and ripple iron to the front room. There is a tall corrugated fibro fence to the street boundary.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Although set behind a super six fence, the vernacular elements of the house including the use of corrugated and ripple iron cladding are evident from the street. There are only a few corrugated iron clad houses remaining in Geraldton. The simple style and form of the house contributes to the streetscape of the area.
