This rendered brick house has a tiled gable roof with a separate gable to the front room. To the north and west, the main roof extends to cover a verandah which is supported on timber posts set on tall tapered rendered masonry columns. The house has been extended to the rear. The timber framed windows are casement style and the window to the front room has a tiled awning which is supported on timber brackets. The unusual rendered chimneys are roofed with lateral vents. There is a large Norfolk island pine (*araucaria heterophylla*) in the front garden.
