Located on one block and situated behind a high brick wall these two timber framed houses have a hipped corrugated iron roof and are clad with fibro and weatherboard. A separate hipped verandah roof covers each of the front verandahs which have some fibro infill. Windows are timber framed and double hung. To the rear each building has a fibro clad lean-to and to the side each has a metal chimney. (see 27B Urch Street.)
