G38 was granted to Patrick Hogan, an Enrolled Pensioner Guard, in 1874. By 1904 the property was occupied by Michael McGuinness. By 1914 the property was owned by Francis McGuinness.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The ruin of the Pensioner Guards Cottage has considerable historic significance as evidence of the settlement of Pensioner Guards on the Greenough Front and Back Flats in the 1870s. Although in poor condition, the place is representative of the simple style of construction that was prevalent in the area at this time. Furthermore, the cottage is evidence of the use of local materials.
