Located on the west side of Edward Road immediately north of Bootenal Road, this is the site only of a gate-keeper's cottage believed to have been built in 1886. The cottage was associated with the Geraldton-Walkaway Railway line which was constructed in 1886 (See also Place Nos. 114,119 & 198). The cottage was occupied in 1911 by the Kielys, later by Josie McCagh, Maria Lynch and then used by the Caligaros. The building was demolished in 1990.
