The site of Maley's Cottage and Barn is located on the west side of Company Road approximately 1.5 kilometres north of McCartney Road. The small stone cottage had a verandah to the front and lean-to at the rear.

James Smith took up the title in 1877. The property was later owned by J.S. Maley of Home Cottage (Place No. 16). His son, John M. Maley and wife Ethel (nee Clinch) moved into the cottage in 1897. J.M. Maley was declared bankrupt in 1910 and the property was purchased by Joshua Waldeck. The house was improved and renovated for Fletcher Waldeck's intended bride, but the marriage did not take place as planned and the house was never again occupied. (Source: Gary Martin)
