Located to the east of the track which runs along the railway line, this cottage has been considerably altered over the years. The only visible evidence of the original four-roomed stone cottage is the two large stone chimneys at each end of the gable corrugated iron roof. The verandahs have been enclosed with corrugated iron sheeting and concrete blocks.

James Rumble took up the title to VL 262 in 1867. With his brother, William, he walked to Geraldton to work on the jetty for finance to buy the land. He also assisted in building St James' Church (Place No. 82). James Rumble died in 1908. The farm was then owned by his daughter, Sarah Wilton.
