The Kurrajong Building consisted of a rendered brick shop front with a verandah extending over the front footpath. To the rear a timber framed residence was clad with weatherboards to window sill height and fibro sheeting above. The building burnt down in 2005.

Prior to World War 2 the building accommodated Clem Orr and Company - agents for machinery, cars and trucks etc. In the early 1940's Horrie Peet purchased the business and carried on as a General Agency for a number of years, before converting the building into a deli. Following his death, Horrie's wife continued to run the business for 10 years before selling to the Mooreheads in 1978. The building was then renovated and renamed the Kurrajong Cafe. The building burnt down in mid 2005.
