Mullewa's original nine-hole golf course was located in the area north of the old railway dam and alongside the rifle range. In 1934 construction of a new course commenced on a nature reserve amongst hilly country west of the recreation ground but this was later abandoned because rock affected play. The present 18-hole course was constructed in the late 1950s, after several years of hard work, near the merging of some heavy country with the sand plain. A new clubhouse was constructed in 1961 for a cost of 4,000 pounds.
