

## **Vehicle Inspections – FAQ's**

- **Where does the inspection take place?** Airport workshop, Gordon Garret Drive Moonyoonooka
- **Is there a map to help find the workshop?** The City of Geraldton – Greenough does not have one available as yet, but directions can be found in the local street directory, Business guide or Yellow pages
- **Where do I pay for the inspection?** At the Cashiers Office in Civic Centre on Cathedral Avenue, alternatively payment by eftpos is available on site at the Airport Workshop while the Vehicle Examiner is on site.
- **When am I required to pay for the inspection?** Before the inspection takes place, as you are required to take the receipt with you to the inspection.
- **What am I required to bring to the inspection?** Please see checklist available from Cashiers Office at Civic centre on Cathedral Ave or City of Geraldton- Greenough website.
- **Do I need to stay with the vehicle during the inspection?** We prefer that you remain with the vehicle during the inspection.
- **Can I drive my vehicle to the inspection if the yellow sticker has expired?** Only if the defects listed have been rectified and you vehicle is still currently registered
- **Can I obtain a temporary permit, to drive the vehicle, from the City of Geraldton - Greenough?** No this can only be done through The Department of Planning and Infrastructure, Licensing Centre. This can be found in Geraldton on Chapman Road.
- **What should I do if I am unable to make my appointment?** If you are unable to attend your pre-arranged appointment, please call either the cashiers office or Jeff at the workshop and inform them.
- **Is there cancellation fee?** At present, The City of Geraldton – Greenough does not have a set fee for cancellations, however in some circumstances, as advised by the inspector, a cancellation fee may apply.

- **What sort of things will be looked at, checked during my inspection?** There is a checklist available from Cashiers office at the Civic Centre, or on the City of Geraldton – Greenough website.
- **If I have a yellow sticker will the inspection only look at defects, which are listed on the sticker?** No, The vehicle is subject to a full roadworthy examination ( this is written in red writing on the bottom of their defect notice)
- **How do I know what category my vehicle fits into? For example it says less than 4.5tonne with load. E.g. only some 22 seater buses fall into the higher weight category.** The GVM is listed on the vehicle compliance plate under the bonnet. Each vehicle is different, please be sure to check yours, so you are not over charged.
- **Is there a lesser fee, for a re-inspection of a minor inspection?** No, there is no lesser fee, the same cost will be charged for each inspection you do not pass.
- **What can I do if I disagree with the verdict of my inspection?** You have the right to go to another vehicle inspection centre if you don't agree or your opinions differ from the inspectors.
