INFRINGEMENT NOTICES

Should you receive an Infringement Notice for litter, parking, dog or off-road vehicles, it can be paid by post (PO Box 101, Geraldton WA 6531) or at the City of Geraldton-Greenough Cathedral Avenue, Geraldton during normal office hours.

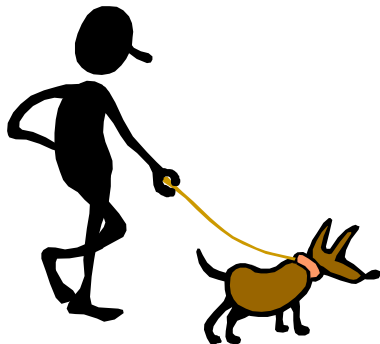
DEAR COMMUNITY MEMBERS

This educational pamphlet has been compiled to provide a knowledge and understanding of the requirements of the Ranger Services.

City of Geraldton-Greenough employs five full-time Rangers, a Senior Ranger and a Coordinator and these officers patrol all the areas within the region on a regular basis. It is in these areas and on popular beach areas that City Rangers find that some people in the general community may be just a little careless when it comes to litter control, their dogs, parking or off-road vehicles.

One of our Ranger Services primary roles is to educate and foster a more caring and responsible commitment by members of the general community, in particular those persons whose chosen activities fall within the duties and responsibilities of the Rangers to monitor and control.

To achieve the objective, there are a few basic rules the City would like to point out:



THE RULES

LITTER CONTROL

Litter is any material that you do not require, such as drink cans or bottles, papers, tree branches, cigarette butts, apple cores and much more.

We ask all of you to place litter in the bin. If you are going to the tip, tie your load down, better still, cover your load first, and if any material falls off, stop and pick it up.

In the City of Geraldton-Greenough, we have Clean-Up Australia Day and a Tidy Towns award, and of course, May Day. So please do your part and help keep the City clean.

Basic Rules

- ★ All litter should be disposed of Hygienically.
- ★ Take all necessary precautions.
- ★ Remember- this is your town. Keep it clean.
- ★ Dispose of litter responsibly.

OFF-ROAD VEHICLES

We still have a small problem with drivers and riders in the prohibited areas within our townsite.

THE RULES CONTINUED

If you are not sure where you can go, contact the Rangers for a map. We have set aside areas for off-road vehicles.

DOG CONTROL

The law provides that all dogs in the City of Geraldton-Greenough over the age of three (3) months must be registered with the City in the name of a person over the age of 18.

Call the Rangers for information about the exact location of dog exercise areas.

PARKING

Ranger Services provide a public car parking management service. Please check the signs for the length of time and purpose for which you may use the space.

Remember, the disabled bays are reserved for those who hold a current ACROD permit ONLY. Don't be surprised if you receive an infringement notice for parking in these bays if you do not hold an ACROD permit.

Also, think about the worker who has to unload or load their commercial vehicle. Leave the loading bays vacant for them.
