## **About Wanslea**

Wanslea is a not-for-profit organisation that was founded in Perth in 1943. The organisation was the initiative of the Women's Australian National Services (WANS), led in Perth by Florence Hummerston.

At Wanslea, we aim to promote community, family and individual development. By helping families to thrive, we are working towards a healthier, safer, and more inclusive Australia. Everything we do is guided by our three core values, which shape our culture, services and organisational direction. These are:

**Respect** – We treat all who interact with us respectfully, honouring their differences and input.

Integrity – We work in a fair, honest and respectful way that values our clients and partners.

**Collaboration** – We collaborate with our clients, other organisations and the government for the best outcomes for children and families.

Wanslea provides services to families and children in metropolitan, regional, rural and remote areas of the state. Five main streams of services are offered:

- Family Support
- Out of Home Care (including Foster Care)
- Community Capacity Building
- Early Learning and Development
- Early Childhood Early Intervention (NDIS Partner in the Community)

Wanslea has offered early Learning and Development programs for over thirty years. We operate six centre-based care centres, family daycare services in metro and regional WA and an in-home care service that spreads across Western Australia, Tasmania and the Northern Territory. Our programs support over one hundred and fifty educators who care for and educate 1500 children each week ranging from six weeks to twelve years, using various childcare options.

Wanslea collaborates with various partners on various programs. The two key early childhood partnerships are the WA Inclusion Agency (WAIA) with Communicare and One Tree and the Early Childhood Approach (ECA) with the NDIA. The WAIA assists all eligible early childhood education and care (ECEC) services to be confident and capable of including all children in their programs. The ECA program supports children under the age of seven years who may have developmental delays or disabilities to reach their fullest potential.
