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1. Summary

The purpose of this document is to present the City's 2019-20 Capital Program, which comprises:

- \$20 million Asset Renewal Program
- \$6.9 million New Capital Program

The City has applied the funding profiles within the City's Long Term Financial Plan when preparing both the Asset Renewal Program and New Capital Program, as well as taking into account anticipated external contributions such as government grants. The Capital Program is contingent on confirmation of funding profiles.

1.1. Projects carried forward from FY2018-19

Several projects budgeted for in FY2018-19 have not been constructed, and as such the funding allocated in the FY2018-19 budget has been carried forward to FY2019-20 budget.

1.1.1. Renewal Projects

The \$20 million for renewal projects contains \$170,000 carried forward from FY2018-19. These include the following:

- Sanford Street path construction \$110,000
- Maley Bridge Renewal \$60,000.

1.1.2. New Capital Projects

The \$6.9 million for New Capital Projects contains \$2,950,000 carried forward from FY2018-19. These include the following:

- Cape Burney Development \$1,560,000 (It is anticipated that the City will recover these costs at the completion of the project).
- Arthur Rd new alignment \$1,310,000 (These funds are sourced from the BBRF Grant monies).
- Hill Way turning Circle \$80,000

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2. Asset Renewal Program

2.1. Introduction

The Asset Renewal Program contains a total of **\$20 million** to renew existing assets. This amount includes approximately \$1.6 million of secured grants and anticipated plant and fleet disposal income.

The City has a large portfolio of community assets under its control which forms an integral part of providing services to the community. These assets include roads, drainage, paths, bridges, lights, buildings, airport, plant & fleet, coastal infrastructure, parks and open space recreational assets. The replacement cost of our assets is in the order of \$1 billion dollars, with the annual budget allocation associated with renewal of these assets forming a large part of the City's Capital Program.

The City has evaluated the priorities of nominated projects at a project and portfolio level, developing a Program focusing on asset and network condition, risk and level of service.

The projects listed are subject to change during the course of the year due to potential for unexpected changes in asset condition and priorities requiring a reallocation of funding accordingly.

The following figure summarises proposed FY2019-20 expenditure at a portfolio level.

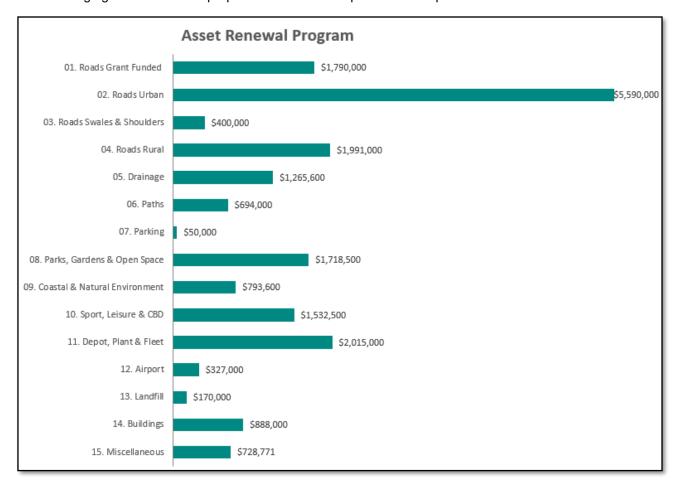

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2.2. Portfolio Commentary

The following figure summarises budget trends for select portfolios over 4 years.

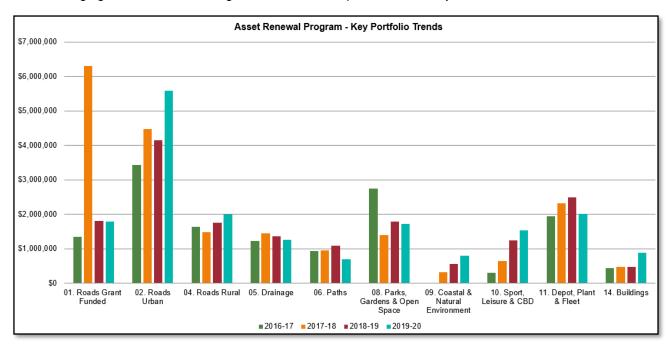

Roads Grant Funded: The City has applied for grant funding on four road renewal projects to be partly funded by the Stated Government through the Regional Road Group program. The projects have been selected based on road assessments, with the grant contribution being 2/3rds of the project budgets. The road projects comprise: Flores Road in Webberton, Chapman Valley Road; Goulds Road; and Walkaway Nangetty Road.

Urban Roads: Urban Roads: Projects have been prioritised based on routine road condition inspections with priority given to higher order roads and minimising future maintenance demand. As an example a high order busy road that is in poor condition would be given equal consideration to a quiet residential street that is in very poor condition.

The City will continue to renew lower order roads with chip seal and higher order roads will continue to receive asphalt reconstruction. In advance of the renewal program the City will undertake a series of pavement testings to determine the characteristics of the basecourse. Roads that display signs of pavement failure will be tested to determine what renewal treatment will best suit the conditions. It is anticipated that the Pavement testing program for FY2019-20 will drive the renewals program for FY2020-21.

Swales and Shoulders: The City allocates funding each year towards renewal works on road swales and shoulders, which preserves the road pavement and surface. The City have had success utilising the PolyCom stabilising aid on the road shoulders which binds the materials creating an impermeable surface, thus increasing water resistance and providing protection to the road pavement. The treated shoulders remain stable for longer (less scouring and rutting) requiring less maintenance in the long run, enabling the City to treat and renew more road shoulders within the network.

Rural Roads: Unsealed road projects have been prioritised through gravel thickness observations made during routine maintenance. Typically gravel resheeting involves ripping existing materials and re-compacting with 100mm of gravel.

Officers have continued to allocate funding to undertake emergent renewal works on harvest route roads in the Mullewa district. During harvest season FY2018-19 the City recommended a 70km/hr speed on gravel roads and haulage routes. Along with additional water truck and roller resources, the harvest routes held up extremely well over the period with minimal problem areas being reported. These measures will continue into FY2019-20 to extend the life of the rural roads.

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Drainage: Projects have been prioritised based on routine inspections with priority given to known flood areas. Condition assessments on drainage assets are ongoing, current findings suggest that the drainage surface renewal backlog (gully grates, pit lids and manhole covers) is being addressed and the focus in future years will shift to below ground assets.

On the back of the Geraldton Coastal Hazard Risk Management and Adaption Planning Project, the City will be undertaking a CBD drainage catchment and flood study to rationalise the existing drainage system in order to determine and design future drainage requirements. It is expected that the outcome from the flood study will determine drainage renewals within the CBD area. As such, only high priority and high risk drainage renewals within the CBD have been included in the FY2019-20 program.

Paths: Path projects have been developed based on routine visual inspections to determine the condition of the path. Replacement of slab paver footpaths continue to be a priority, particularly in and around the CBD, shopping precincts, schools and medical facilities. The cost of path renewals continues to be a challenge for the City, as existing site conditions (e.g. verge slopes, driveways, underground services) can impact greatly on the budget to deliver the project. The City officers are making efforts to improve the design and estimating process in order to better predict the actual cost of pathway construction prior to budget allocation. The benefits of these measures will begin to be seen in FY2020-21.

Parks: Projects have been prioritised based on routine inspections and the implementation of the Parks Master Planning recommendations. A significant project is the renewal of the skate park and basketball court at Forrester Park. These renewals have been taken from the Parks Master Planning recommendations and will provide a greater level of service to those residents living in the outer suburbs.

The garden renewal program will continue with a focus on high traffic areas such as Brand Highway medians from Jarrah Street to the tavern, Cathedral Avenue medians from Maitland to Carson Terrace and Chapman Road from Northgate Shopping Centre to Forrest Street. These areas are high traffic and will improve the appearance of the entry areas into the City. The City will also be working with Main Roads WA to plan the beautification of the medians along John Willcock Link.

Depot, Plant & Fleet: The City will renew \$2 million of plant, fleet and equipment, with the majority of expenditure being on renewal of aged plant such as Trucks (Light & Medium), Rollers and Light Vehicles. Fleet and plant changeover times are aligned as best possible with industry good practice, City procedures and City budget constraints. Plant and Fleet Asset Management Plan has been drafted and the ten year plan has been used to determine the renewals for FY2019-20.

Sport Infrastructure: Sporting Light Tower replacement program will continue in FY2019-20 with Little Athletics Sporting Light Towers to be replaced as the existing infrastructure had reached the end of its life and posing safety risks to the community. The 50m outdoor pool at the Aquarena is scheduled for renewal in FY2020-21. The design component for this project is proposed for FY2019-20.

Airport: Renewals at the Airport are generally minor items such as replacement security cameras, scanners and apron lights. FY2019-20 contains the staged renewal of Hangar 116 due to deterioration of the structure and hangar door tracks. A detailed structural report and quote was obtained to determine the estimated budget for this project of \$230,000, which represents stage 1 of programmed renewal to extend the life and functionality of the Hangar.

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3. New Capital Program

3.1. Introduction

The New Capital Program contains **\$6.9 million** to plan, design and construct brand new projects or to upgrade existing assets. Funding sources for the 2019-20 Capital Program is detailed in the below table:

The New Capital Program has been developed from a list of over 200 project nominations, which have been evaluated using the City's 11 endorsed community criteria. Projects have been placed into one of five portfolios, with officers using the criteria scoring, project information, grant funding opportunities and other factors to develop the Program.

The FY2019-20 Program is part of a 3 Year Program. The 3 Year Program builds upon the work undertaken in previous year, with the Program refined based on new project priorities, funding profiles and a variety of other factors.

3.2. Summary

FY2019-20 sees a measured approach to New Capital expenditure. Most New Capital nomination projects are budgeted at less than \$0.5M. The exceptions to this are:

- The CBD Revitalisation project which is budgeted at \$750,000,
- The Coastal Hazard Risk Management Adaptation Planning Project budgeted at \$500,000.

The following projects have been carried forward from FY2018-19 reserves:

- Arthur Road new alignment \$1,310,000 (externally funded through BBRF grant)
- Cape Burney Development \$1,560,000 (cost to be recovered upon completion of project)
