HOW YOUR RATES ARE CALCULATED

Step 1 Total rates required to run Greater Geraldton

Cost of running the 4 City

Minus non-rate revenue (grants, fees & charges, other)

Equals the amount of rates revenue reauired

Step 2 Rate in the dollar calculated

Divide the rates

revenue required By the

combined rental value of all rateable properties

To calculate the rate in the dollar

Step 3 What you pay

Multiply the rate in the dollar

By your property's Gross Rental Value (GRV)

To calculate your rates for the year

RATE CATEGORIES

The 2023/2024 rates in the dollar and minimum payments are detailed below:

RATING CATEGORIES 2023/2024	RATE IN THE DOLLAR (CENTS)	MINIMUM PAYMENTS PER ASSESSMENT
CGG GRV	13.3250	\$1,027
CGGUV	0.5682	\$1,027

Each category reflects the level of rating required to raise the necessary revenue for Council to operate efficiently and provide the range of services, programs, infrastructure as well as facilities for our entire locality.

Rates have risen by 3% in the 2023/24 financial year, which is less than half the rate of inflation.

RUBBISH REMOVAL CHARGES

The rubbish removal charge for 2023/2024 has been set at \$425 per bin, serviced weekly.
