This timber framed weatherboard clad house has a corrugated iron gambrel roof with a separate gable roof to the front and a skillion roof to the rear (west). The building has a hipped bull nose verandah which is supported on turned timber posts. Windows are timber framed with some double hung and some casement in style. To the main room below the gable, the casement windows have a timber and corrugated iron awning. There is a corbelled brick chimney to the rear. The weatherboard wall cladding has been replaced with fibro plank to the front and southern side.
