This small timber framed corrugated iron clad cottage has a steeply pitched painted corrugated iron gable roof which has a broken back which covers the front (north) verandah with a skillion roof to the rear. The front verandah is enclosed with fibro and timber framed louvre windows to the north east with scalloped boards below the east end of the verandah. The west end of the verandah is partly enclosed with a fibro balustrade. There is a low corrugated fibro fence to the street boundary.
