This timber framed cottage has weatherboard cladding to the front facade and corrugated iron to the sides. The hipped painted corrugated iron roof has a skillion roof punctuated by a brick chimney to the rear with a lean-to roof beyond. To the front (west) facade the separate verandah roof is supported on chamfered timber posts. Windows are timber framed and double hung. To the rear there is a separate corrugated iron garage and a windmill. There is a low rendered brick wall with pillars which support a picket fence and gate to the street boundary.
