This house is clad with fibro to the front facade. The main gambrel corrugated iron roof has a lean-to roof to the rear which covers a fibro clad extension. To the front (east) facade, a separate verandah roof is supported on metal posts. Windows are aluminium framed and a low brick wall forms the street boundary.
