The corrugated iron gambrel roof of this timber framed house extends to cover the surrounding verandahs to the north and east which are supported on timber posts. The walls of the house are clad with weatherboard to half height with fibro above. Windows are double hung and timber framed. There is a corbelled brick chimney to the south. A masonry wall with rendered piers and timber picket infill forms the property frontage.
