Please note: This assessment was undertaken prior to the demolition of the building in c1997. This large stone building has a large gable roof with a smaller gable roof to the front concrete block section. A surrounding hipped verandah is supported on metal poles. The rear stone section features rendered sills and lintels to openings while the concrete block section has rusticated concrete block quoining accentuated by the paint treatment to the corners. The building has french doors and a combination of casement and double hung windows. The place is almost identical to 69 Forrest Street.
