Directly fronting on to Chapman Road, this painted stone and brick building has a high pitched gable roof with stucco infill to the gable ends to the west and south. A separate hipped verandah roof is supported on timber posts with a simple balustrade. Windows are casement style with a metal awning to the main window to the west. There is a corbelled chimney to the roof apex to the south and a brick lean-to to the rear.
