This weatherboard clad timber framed house has a corrugated iron gambrel roof with a lean-to roof to the side which covers a weatherboard clad extension. To the front, a separate verandah roof is supported on timber posts. Windows are timber framed and double hung, with awnings over side windows. A low limestone block wall forms the street boundary.
