This small timber framed weatherboard and corrugated iron clad house is set well back from the street. The place has a gambrel corrugated iron roof which extends to cover the front verandah roof to the east elevation while there is a skillion roof to the rear. The verandah is supported on timber posts. The front roof has been modified to include a gable. Windows are timber framed with a mixture of awning and casement styles. A brick chimney is sited to the rear of the main roof.
