This small timber framed house has a corrugated iron gable roof which extends to cover the front verandah. A skillion roof covers an extension to the rear. The verandah which is supported on timber posts and is partly enclosed with lattice. The house is clad with weatherboard to the front facade and fibro to the sides. Entry to the verandah is via three timber steps. A small corbelled rendered brick chimney is sited to the apex of the gable.
