This house was demolished in 2008. The following description is from the 1997 Municipal Inventory: This brick house has a combination hipped and gable roof with a separate hipped bull nose verandah which is supported on metal poles. A small timber framed fibro clad lean-to is attached to the rear of the building. The gable end has roughcast and timber batten infill. The red face brickwork has a rendered band at half wall height to the front (north) elevation and has been rendered to the west facade. Original windows have been replaced with aluminium frames. To the rear there is a red brick corbelled chimney and the street boundary has a low rendered brick fence.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Although some of original elements have been removed, the building is representative of the style of its era with the exposed face brickwork, corbelled brick chimney and bull nose verandah. The place makes an important contribution to the built environment of the area.
